# A CHILD'S FUTURE BEGINS AT HOME

Field trips along the back roads of Woodstock in search of milkweed soon ensued.

This experience caused us to reflect on how eagerly we accepted responsibility for these creatures of God. We excitedly took them in, enjoying the challenge of helping them grow and awaiting the transformation we knew was coming. Experience had taught us that a beautiful metamorphosis was just a few weeks away!

This is not unlike what we do for our Family Promise guests. Our program serves as a sort of chrysalis. We bring families in and, as with the caterpillars, furnish sustenance while surrounding them with care. Sustenance that often extends beyond food, shelter, and securing employment.
